

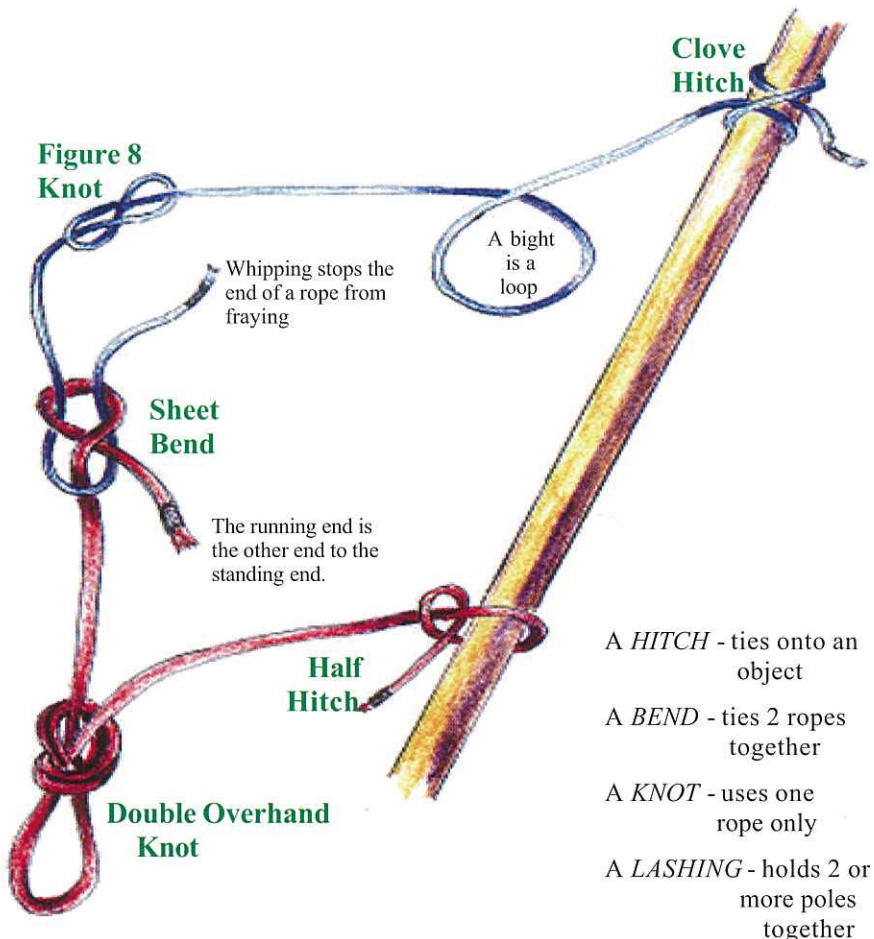

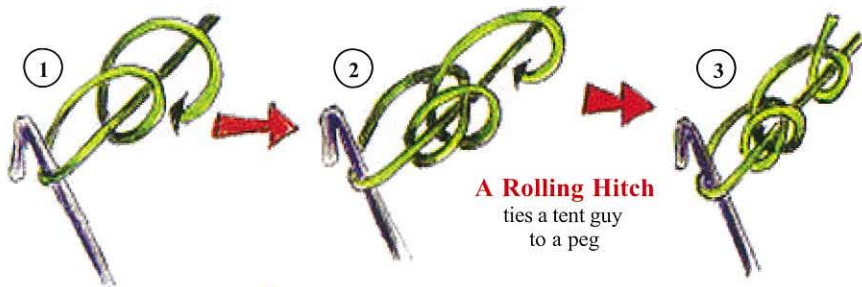
KNOTS



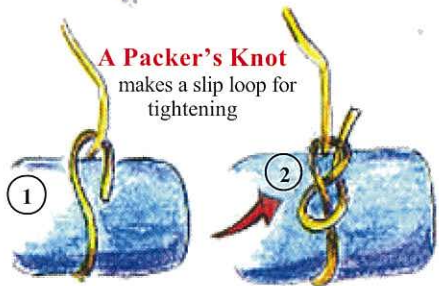
Knots are useful for a range of outdoor activities like camping, boating, climbing and abseiling.

To tie knots successfully you need to know the use for the knot and the type of rope it works best on - this is more useful than remembering its name!

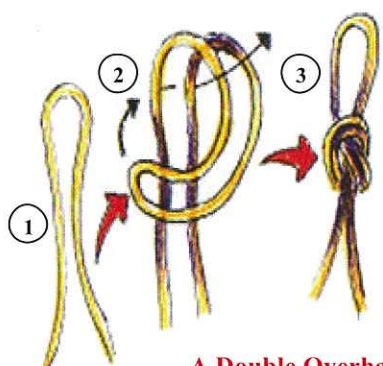




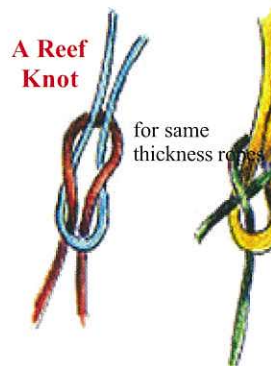
A Rolling Hitch
ties a tent guy
to a peg



A Packer's Knot
makes a slip loop for
tightening



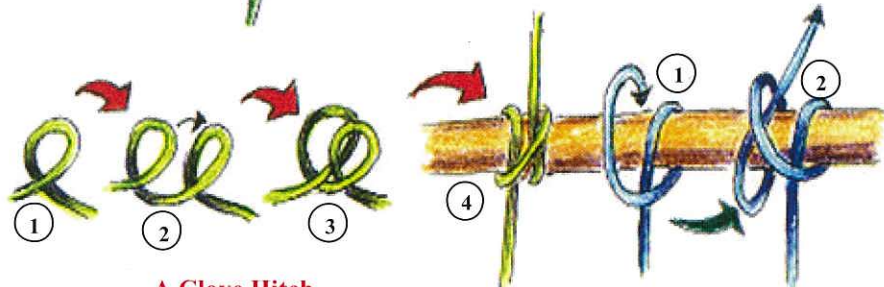
A Double Overhand Knot
makes a loop in a rope.
Also a good way to keep ropes
from tangling when stored



A Reef Knot
for same
thickness ropes



A Sheet Bend
for different
thickness ropes
or tying a rope
to a loop.



A Clove Hitch

Ties a rope to a pole or tree. There are two ways to do it

Once you can tie these knots practice tying them behind your back or with your eyes shut so they become automatic.
